Question 2

- many answers could be features of non drug-seeking back pain presentations (e.g. no fever, no neurology)
- distractibility is not listed as a good discriminator for drug-seeking behaviour (myth)

Question 3

- Confusion about what constituted MANAGEMENT
 - getting collateral information is HISTORY for the purposes of the exam
- Very few candidates mentioned a departmental management plan, involving senior clinicians, giving higher doses of drugs or confronting patient
