Insertion of urethral catheter

CLINICAL SCENARIO STEM:

An 85 yo man Eric White requires a urethral catheter for urinary retention. The intern has seen urethral catheters inserted but has never performed the procedure. An examiner will play the role of the intern

INSTRUCTIONS:

Candidate: “please supervise the intern inserting the urethral catheter.”

Role player: part-task trainer

Examiner: perform task as instructed by candidate. Do not deliberately deviate from instructions, if instructions not given, or get “stuck” from lack of instruction, can ask “what should I do next?”

Assessment criteria:

- Clear instructions
- Logical order
- Supportive
- Explain as you instruct
- Appropriate response to any questions asked
- Technically correct instruction
 - Choice of catheter
 - Sterility
 - Pain minimisation techniques
