- 1. Describe your assessment of the patient presenting to the ED following an episode of syncope, with respect to determining whether a patient is safe for discharge. In particular focus on:
 - Presenting history
 - Past medical history
 - Clinical exam
 - Investigations

Consider the following patient groups:

- 85-year-old male with history of IHD, who collapses without warning. His ECG is normal.
- 50-year-old cyclist who collapses post exercise. He has RBBB on ECG
- 17 year old girl collapses at school with normal exam and ECG
